Entry Requirements

Applied Science	Pass grade in BTEC Extension Certificate or 5,5 grade in GCSE Core and Additional Science. Grade 5 in Maths and 4 in English.
Art and Design	Grade 5 in GCSE Art
Biology	A minimum of 6,6 in Science and Grade 6 in Mathematics and English at GCSE. Students with a high grade 5 Maths GCSE will be considered on an individual basis.
Business Studies	Grade 4 in English and Maths
Chemistry	Grade 6,6 in Science. Grade 6 in Mathematics. Students with a high grade 5 Maths GCSE will be considered on an individual basis.
Drama	Grade 5 in English and Drama at GCSE
Design and Technology	Grade 5 in DT (or related subject) and grade 5 in Maths at GCSE
English Language	Grade 5 in GCSE English or English Literature.
English Literature	Grade 5 in GCSE English Literature and GCSE English Language.
Film Studies	Grade 5 in GCSE English Literature or English Language. Students with high 4 grades would be considered, on the recommendation of their GCSE English teacher.
Geography	Grade 6 in GCSE Geography. In addition a Grade 4 in Maths is required.
Health & Social Care	Grade 4 in GCSE English, with a 5 in Science.
History	Grade 5 in GCSE History
ICT	Grade 4 in English and Maths
Mathematics	Grade 6 at GCSE Mathematics, although Grade 7 is much more realistic for students seeking the highest grades.
Further Mathematics	Grade 7 or above at GCSE.
Photography	Grade 5 at GCSE; distinction at BTEC. The course is open to students who have no prior experience at GCSE level, but you will require a portfolio of work. You must own or have access to a SLR camera and a digital camera
Physical Education (AS & A2)	Grade 4 in GCSE English and Maths. Grade 5 in GCSE PE. Students must be regularly participating in at least one sporting activity. Students without GCSE PE will be considered on an individual basis
Sport (Cambridge Technical)	Grade 4 in GCSE English and Maths. Grade 5 in GCSE Physical Education or Merit in L2 Cambridge National Sport.
Physics	6,6 in GCSE Science and a Grade 6 in GCSE Mathematics. Students with a high grade 5 Maths GCSE will be considered on an individual basis.
Psychology	Grade 5 in English Language and Maths, with a 5 grade in Science. (A high grade 4 would be considered on an individual basis in one of English or Maths).
Religious Studies	Grade 6 in GCSE Religious Studies, full or short course.
