Cambridge Technical Diploma

- Assignments are completed on computers
- All aspects of the course can be found on the VLE to support students learning
- Home learning is set in line with assessment plan
- Students work is submitted in line with the assessment plan
- Feedback is provided in line with the Triple Impact Marking Policy
 - 1) Self and Peer Assessment using Success Criteria
 - 2) Students respond to peer assessment in green pen and submit to teacher
 - 3) Teacher to mark and return for final corrections in green pen in line with assessment plan

GCSE / A-Level PE

- Work is completed in folders
- Worksheets and resources can be found on the VLE
- Home learning is set every week
- Work is marked in relation to target grades using home learning template
- Staff to provide written feedback to students
- Students are provided with time to reflect and respond to feedback in green pen

Child Development GCSE

The Child Development course is made up of an exam, 3 controlled tasks, 1 Child Study worth 30%.

Exam work

- The pupils work in work books for exam work and on paper.
- There will be green pen on exam practice work only. In the reflection time in the lesson this will happen.
- Staff will feed back verbally and written using a faculty template or sticker.

Controlled tasks

- The pupils can work on computer for controlled tasks and the child study.
- There will be no green pen on any of the controlled tasks or the child study.
- It is collated by pupils and marked by staff.
- Pupils receive the end mark but cannot improve their work further in line with exam board expectations.

Health and Social Care A Level – single and double award.

The Course has 2/3 portfolio element made up of 4 (A2 single award) or 6 units (A2 double award) and exam work (1 AS & 1 A2 exam for single award and 2 AS & 2 A2 for double award).

Exam work

- The work is done on paper in folders, home learning is set regularly via Show My Homework.
- There will be green pen marking in reflection time during the lesson.
- Work is marked against their target grades, using verbal and written feedback using the faculty sticker or template.

Portfolio work

- The work is done on paper and on computers.
- There is no green pen marking.
- It is collated by pupils and marked by staff.
- Pupils will receive guided feedback, both written and verbal and are able to redraft their work once prior to final marking.
- Interim and final firm deadlines will be set throughout the course.
- Home learning will be set via Show My Homework.
- Throughout pupils will be given guidance as to how marks equate to grades based on the most recent OCR raw score grade boundaries.

<u>PSHEe</u>

PSHEe is not assessed formally, pupils will have key work assessed within their work booklets every 2 terms.

- Pupils have a work booklet and can use paper, posters or computers to express their work as appropriate.
- Faculty Stickers are already in the booklet to be used by the member of staff.
