SOLUTION TO FATHER CHRISTMAS PUZZLE

Father Christmas has two children. These could be BB (boy youngest and boy eldest), BG, GB, or GG.

a) We know that one child is a boy. This rules out GG – leaving just three possibilities. Only in BB and GB, the younger child is a boy. So the probability that the

youngest child is a boy = $\frac{2}{3}$.

b) We know that the older of the two children is a boy. This rules out GG and GB – leaving just two possibilities.
