An early run out in the Devizes innings saw **Jack Hopper** leave the pitch with no runs having faced only 3 deliveries. **Jake Roberts** started to get into the bowling of the Hardenhuish team and managed a respectable 24 before being bowled. **Kieran Chivers** played a steady role supporting Jake, scoring 5 runs before playing onto his own stumps. However, with the rate well down by the 10th over, it seemed all over for the Devizes boys.

They did manage to last the whole 20 overs, but only scored 30 runs for the remaining time, (averaging 3 runs per over), when an average of 8 was needed to win the game.
