Duke of Edinburgh Award: Gold

Your son/daughter is being offered the opportunity to participate in the Duke of Edinburgh Award. This is a long running award scheme that gives young people the chance to learn new skills, challenge themselves and gain further recognition for their achievements outside school. The award is recognised in the UK and around the world and many people have found that it has given them a leading edge when applying for courses and jobs. Participating in the award brings new interests, develops key skills as well as being enjoyable and memorable. Students can participate in Gold even if they have not completed the earlier awards.

There are five sections to the award: Volunteering, Physical, Skills, Expedition and Residential. The first three sections are carried out independently but with support from staff at school. Each student will choose activities personal to them and complete an hour a week for the duration shown in the table below. The expedition is a 3-day, two-night walking and camping trip. Students will be trained in the required navigation and camping skills and will participate in a day walk and practice and assessed expeditions. The expeditions will take place between March and July 2020, dates will be confirmed as soon as they are known. For the expedition the school can provide group kit (tents, stoves, maps) and participants will have to provide their own personal kit and food. The residential will be organised and paid for individually by participants.

All participants must undertake a **further** 6 months in the Physical or Skills section.

If participants did not complete Silver they must complete a **further** 6 months one of the longer sections. Each section requires an average of one hour per week for the duration of that section

The cost of completing the award is £375 in total, covering enrolment and the expeditions including group kit hire. Financial aid is available for students in receipt of PP.
