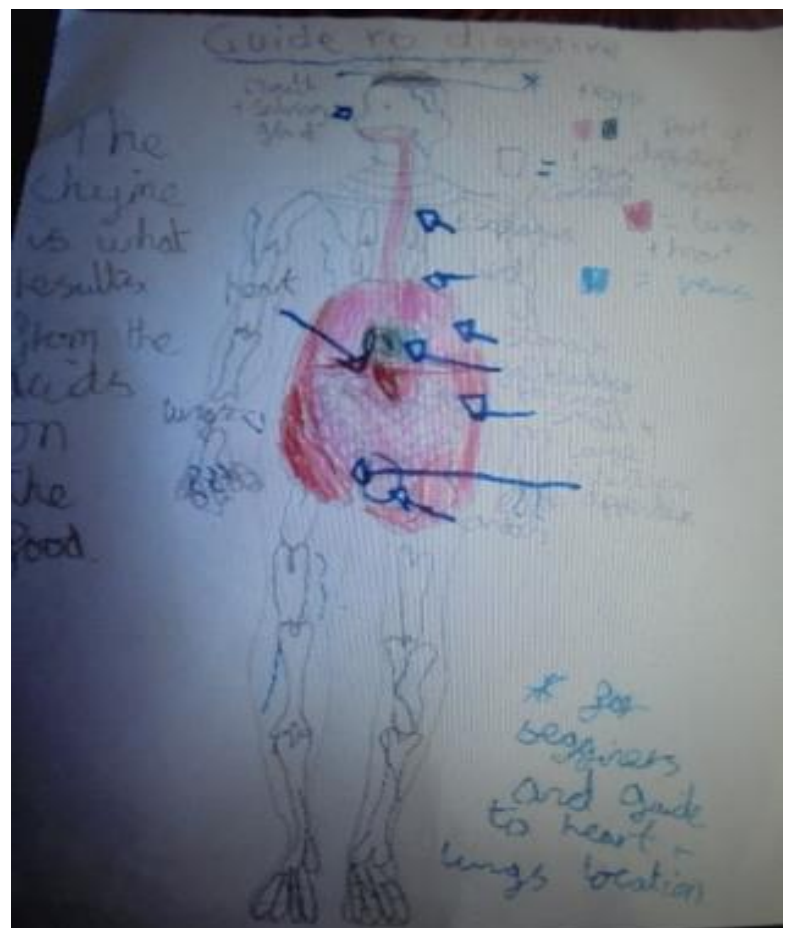

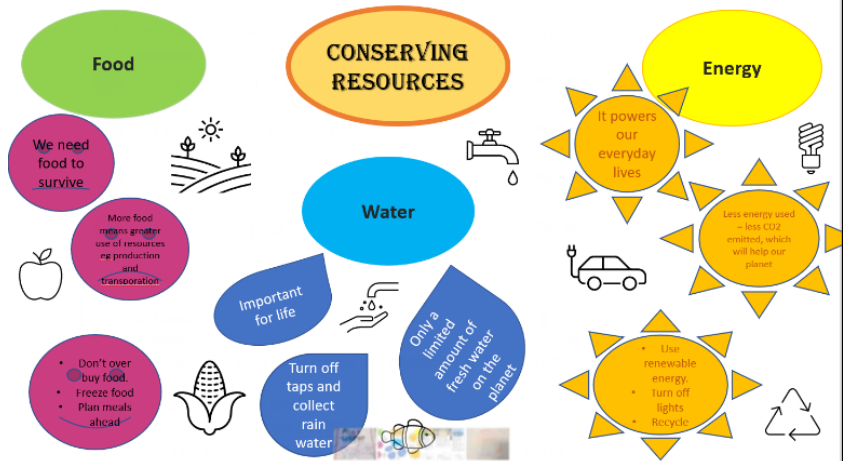
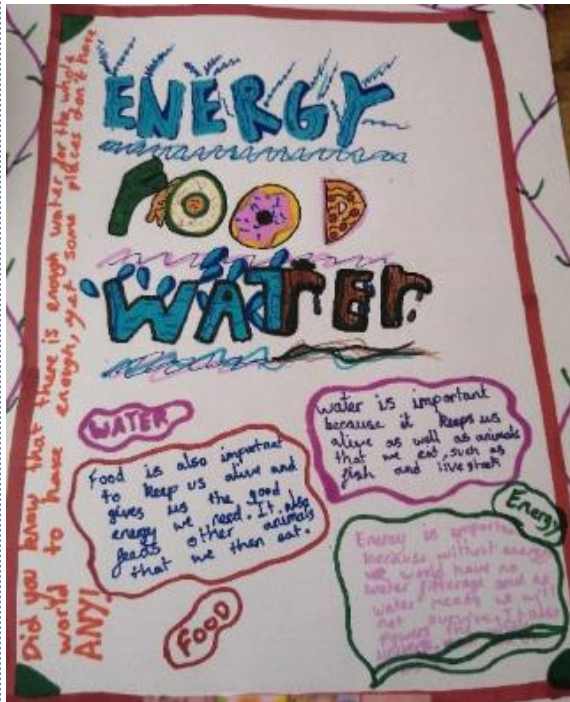

**Top tips to help:**

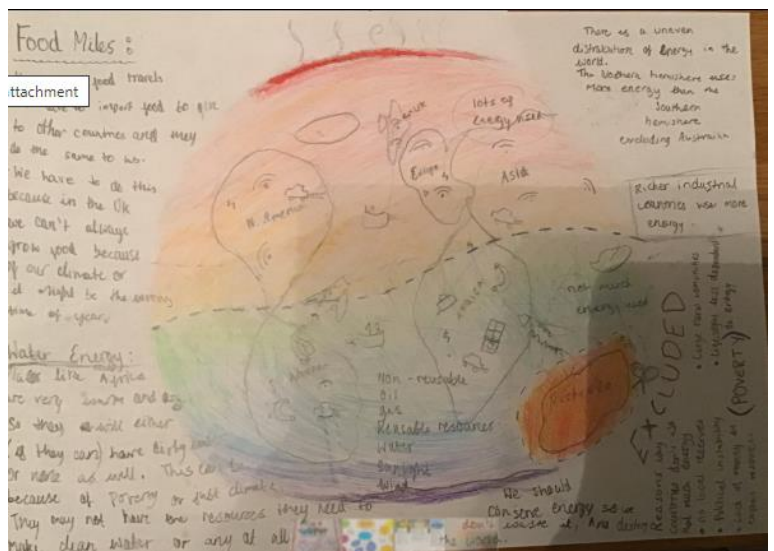
- Grow more crops in your garden.

- Governments need to ensure these renewable ways of creating energy are available to everyone, even those in rural areas.
- Only use the energy you need in your home, e.g. turn off lights, heaters, televisions and portable gaming.

**Top tips to help:**

- Take shorter showers.
- Turn the tap off when cleaning your teeth.
- Patch up leaking water pipes.
- Use a full load in your washing machine.
- Use a water butt in your garden.

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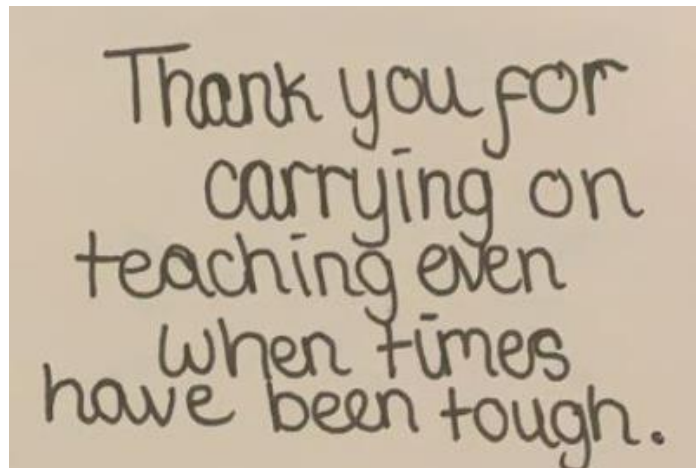
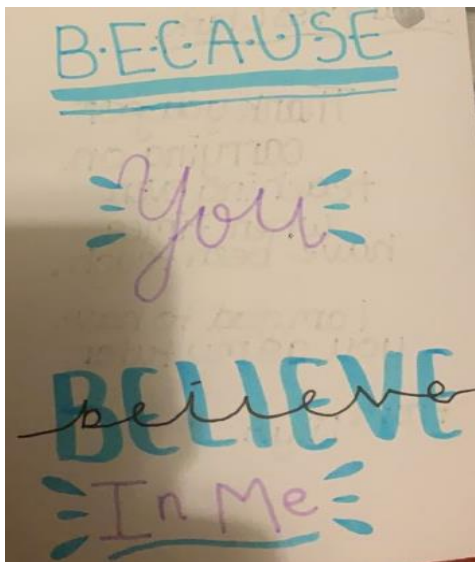
This week in tutor my tutor group have had the loveliest idea of writing thank you cards to their teachers! 😊 This is why tutor time is one of my favourite lessons of the day.
